Under general supervision, the successful candidate will be expected to carry out the tasks required to perform the functions associated with emergency operations and non-emergent operations. Tasks include, but are not limited to: emergency medical technician (provide pre-hospital care to the level of EMT-Basic, using specialized equipment). Other tasks involve public interaction while assisting education activities, routine station & equipment maintenance and house-keeping duties.

Some Responsibilities in this role:

- Report to duty on time and when assigned
- Candidates will be expected to work well in a team-oriented atmosphere, be able to receive, understand and carry out orders (both verbal and written), communicate well, project a professional image, maintain a physical fitness level commensurate to the requirements of the job and good personal hygiene, possess good interpersonal relationship skills and maintain their composure in emergency situations.
- Learn and remain proficient in the use of portable ventilators and IV pumps.
- Remain educated in new training procedures and topics related to prehospital/interfacility.
- Attend quarterly In service Training and other training opportunities to meet recertification requirements.
- Learn general knowledge of facility location and layout throughout the local transport area.

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- Maintain contact with receiving facility and medical control physician of patient conditions and needs
- Maintain ability to operate electronic communication to include portable and mobile radios, electronic patient care records.
- Work well with as well as under other agencies as requested under needed circumstances
- Must be physically able to lift 150lbs

Skills/Requirements:

- High School diploma or GED required.
- Will require a current, valid South Carolina EMT certificate, and National Registry certificate. Personnel must possess a certificate to be good for at least 12 months at time of hire or must show enough training hours for recertification.
- Applicants must provide a five (5) year driving record at the time of interview.
- Currently possess or obtain a South Carolina driver's license within two (2) weeks of hire.
